They have contributed themselves in this great cause to provide basic education and exposure to society. Mamta foundation has always emphasized on women empowerment. Today it successfully operating with 35 children. To support financially to this great cause, Mamta Foundation always seek support and funding from nearby Schools, Colleges, Trustees, industrialist, politicians, MLAs, social workers & Civilians in the form of Cash, Food, Vegetables, Grocery, Cloths, Shoes, Medicines etc. Today they are not getting any financial support from Government authorities. It has constantly working towards increasing the life span of HIV +ve children by providing high protein diet, nutritional support and medical treatment. 



India marks January 26 as its Republic Day every year. In 2023, the country is celebrating its 74th Republic Day. While India gained independence from the British Raj in 1947, it wasn't until January 26, 1950, that the Indian Constitution came into effect, and India became a sovereign state, declaring it a republic. Dr. B.R. Ambedkar headed the Drafting Committee of the Constitution. Additionally, Constitution Day is celebrated in India on November 26 every year, as on November 26, 1949, the Constituent Assembly of India adopted the Constitution of India.







