
COVID-19

If you need a Student visa to study in the UK, and we haven't yet been in contact with you, we will contact you within four months of the start of your course with a link to an online questionnaire. You will need to complete this before we can issue your Confirmation of Acceptance for Studies (CAS). A CAS is issued after:

• we have received and reviewed your CAS questionnaire responses













- any other information and documents requested have been received
- any necessary deposit has been paid

Once your CAS has been issued, you will be able to access your CAS statement on your?myEssex?applicant portal.

If we find that you are unable to meet all Student visa requirements (including when there have been changes to those requirements made by the Home Office), we may not be able to issue you a CAS.

Fee Status

Your fee status has been determined from the information provided in your application. We may review your fee status during the admissions process and we reserve the right to amend your fee status in accordance with UK Fees and Awards legislation in force at the relevant time. If you think that we have assessed your fee status incorrectly, you should contact Admissions using the contact details at the top of this letter. Please be aware that we are unable to change your fee status after 31 October of the first year of study or 4 weeks after the start of your course if your course does not start in October. Further information about fee status assessment can be found on our fee status web page.

If you have been classified by the University as Home fees, this does not guarantee Student Loans Company funding for fees or living costs. The Student Loans Company will conduct their own eligibility assessment. Once registered at Essex, all students, regardless of funding source and fee status, are liable for their fees.
